27/04/26 Marling Year 7 vs Rednock School: Marling Won by 7 Wickets

The Year 7's turned up to the pavilion at Marling School on a gloriously sunny day, ready to represent the school in their first game of cricket. After losing the toss by naively going 'scissors' while the Rednock captain went 'rock', Atharva's spell as captain had gotten off to a rocky start. Marling were tasked with bowling first and they did not disappoint. Every outfield player had a chance to turn their arm and all did it excellently. Stand out performers were Lucas getting 3 wickets and going for 5 runs, Alex taking 2 wickets for 6 runs and Pratik taking 1 wicket without giving any runs away in his 3 overs. The bowling levels were matched by great work in the field and Rednock were bowled out for 31 runs. The run chase lasted 7 overs with Atharva stepping up and scoring 16 runs not out to guide Marling to victory.

28/04/2026: Marling Year 7- 10 Tennis vs Rednock School

Our two squads travelled to Rednock in our first league match for Year 9 and 10. With extremely windy conditions the students managed it well. After the singles and doubles results the score was 3-3 so a tiebreak shootout was required. Niall and James stepped up and won 10-7, meaning we won overall. Well, done Niall for winning all of his matches. Our Y7 and 8 squad also had a great time, playing some good tennis, especially Miles, who won his singles and doubles matches with Kit.

30/04/26 Marling Year 7 and 8 Tennis vs Dean Close School

Year 7 and 8 boys played our first league match away at Dean Close. Harry and Miles won both singles with Ed and Luther showing some great play but unfortunately losing narrowly. 28/04/26 Marling Year 9 Cricket vs Crypt School: Marling won by 62 runs

The Year 9 cricket team made an excellent start to their season with a convincing 62-run victory over The Crypt School in the County Cup. Batting first in our opening fixture of the season, the team posted a strong total of 154 for 4 wickets. The innings was built around solid partnerships, sensible shot selection, and positive running between the wickets. Special mention goes to Alex, who was the only batter to retire, setting the platform for a competitive and well-managed total. In reply, The Crypt School were immediately put under pressure by disciplined bowling and sharp fielding. Regular wickets prevented Crypt from building any momentum, and they were eventually bowled out for 92. Alex, Mitchell and Pranav played a crucial role in the victory, bowling effectively and helping to bowl Crypt out of the game with key wickets. This was a dominant all-round performance and a very encouraging start to the season.

How do I create an account? Also, why can't I see information for all of the teams?

Do I need to create an account to see the calendar, fixture list and match details?

No, just follow the aforementioned links.

If the links stop working how can I access all of this information?

Type Marling School SOCS into Google and select the first option.

Is it possible to view a team sheet and specific details for each match?

Yes, select "details" for the fixture you are interested in, then select 'team sheet'. If you are asked to enter a password, please enter 'MarlingSports25!'. However, please be aware for safeguarding reasons we are not always able to publish a team sheet. When this is the case, we will email a team sheet directly to parents.

Why doesn't my child's student account work?

Please ask your child to visit the sports hall to speak with a PE teacher, if this is the case.

EXTRA CURRICULAR FAQ'S

How does my child sign up for extra-curricular clubs?

Students need to attend the club and write their name on the register. We then use this register to select teams for any upcoming fixtures.

How does my child sign up for clubs which are run by external coaches?

Students need to attend the club they are interested in and speak directly with the coach, they will then be given all of the sign up information. This includes instructions on how to pay.

When can I purchase a gym pass for my child to use the fitness suite?

Students in KS4 and KS5 can purchase a gym pass via Parent Pay, it is £50 for the year. If there isn't an option to do this on Parent Pay, all of the gym passes have been sold..

Where do extra-curricular clubs take place?

All clubs take place at the sports hall, unless stated otherwise. If there is a change of venue, students will be notified directly by the club's coach.

What uniform should my child wear when taking part in an extra curricular club?

Students are expected to wear the same PE kit at extra curricular-clubs that they wear in PE lessons. For example, when participating in rugby training, they should wear their rugby kit. Please be aware that if students are wearing the wrong kit they may not be allowed to take part in the extra-curricular club. Also, students are not allowed to wear their PE kit into school if they are only participating in a lunch time club.

Will training be cancelled if students have competed in a fixture earlier in the week?

No, training will still take place. However, the coach will let parents and students know in advance if training needs to be cancelled.

If a fixture and training is scheduled for the same day, will training still take place?

No, the fixture takes priority so there will be no training that week.
